- 1a: the quality or state of being apart from company or observation: <u>SECLUSION</u>



What can you do?



Own your online presence: Set the privacy and security settings on at least one service and/or device to your comfort level for information sharing.



Lock down your login: Choose one account and turn on the strongest authentication tools available, such as biometrics, security keys or a unique one-time code through an app on your mobile device. Your usernames and passwords are not enough to protect key accounts like email, banking and social media.



Keep a clean machine: Update your security software, web browser and operating system to have the best defense against viruses, malware and other online threats.



On Your Phone

- Think before you "Allow"
- Review app permissions
 - iPhone Settings Privacy
 - Android Settings app, choose app, tap
 Gear icon
- Delete apps you don't use
- Review settings in Facebook, Instagram, Twitter



Protecting Personally Identifiable Information (PII)

- Social Security Numbers, Driver's License Numbers, Passport Numbers, need to be protected!
 - Don'ts
 - Email
 - Text
 - Save in a place that is shareable by email (Google Drive, OneDrive, Paper!)

Protecting PII

Do's

- Save encrypted (needs a password) –
 Dropbox, Box, Shared Drive
- Paper that is secured (via mail, secure file cabinet)
- Secure upload (https, needs a password, sends a text)
- Use multi-factor authentication
