### HUDSON ONLINE COURSES

Hudson Online courses and programs are created for fully online teaching and learning. This means most work is completed on students' own time schedule as long as the work is submitted on time.

### ON-GROUND COURSES

On-ground courses are offered at one of HCCC's campuses: Journal Square, North Hudson, or Secaucus. On-ground courses could be combined with other modalities. For example, a lab could occur on-ground with the lecture occurring either through remote or online instruction.

### REMOTE COURSES

Remote courses are similar to the experience of being in a face-to-face on-ground class. This means that students will be attending class remotely, or virtually, at the time the class is scheduled.

# Attention HCCC Students!



**Effective December 20, 2021, ALL students taking classes or accessing services on any of HCCC's campuses MUST BE VACCINATED.** Students who are not vaccinated must take online and/or remote classes and utilize online/remote student support services. Most classes and programs and all HCCC services are available remotely.



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR STUDENTS

**Question:** *I already submitted my proof of vaccination for the \$100 Vaccination Incentive. Do I have to submit it again?*

**Answer:** No, you do not have to submit it again. Students who already submitted their proof of vaccination have met the vaccination requirement.

**Question:** *How do I submit my proof of vaccination?*

**Answer:** Students should submit their proof of vaccination by filling out the [Student Vaccination Incentive Request Form](#). Not only will this satisfy the vaccination requirement, you will also receive the \$100 incentive!

**Question:** *I am not yet vaccinated, but would like to get vaccinated. Where can I get vaccinated?*

**Answer:** The COVID-19 vaccine is widely available at local pharmacies such as CVS and Walgreens.

HCCC will again partner with the North Hudson Community Action Corporation (NHCAC) for vaccine and booster administration. Beginning in early October, the NHCAC will be on both campuses to administer first and second doses of the COVID-19 vaccine as well as booster shots for those already vaccinated. We will share details as soon as they are finalized.

**Question:** *Are there medical/religious exemptions for students who cannot be vaccinated for medical or religious reasons?*

**Answer:** Students who cannot be vaccinated are required to take all classes and access all services remotely after December 20, 2021.

**Question:** *I am not vaccinated but my Winter and/or Spring 2022 classes are not available online/remotely. What are my options?*

**Answer:** If your required classes are not available online and/or remotely in the winter and/or spring semester, please email the Return to Campus Task Force at [return@hccc.edu](mailto:return@hccc.edu).

**Question:** *I am a student and I also work on campus. Am I considered a student or an employee?*

**Answer:** If you work on campus, you are considered an employee.

## HCCC Remote College Placement: *You Have Options!*

When enrolling at HCCC, students can choose from three options to determine their college placement:

1. **College Placement Exemptions**  
You may be eligible for college-level coursework by submitting qualifying High School transcripts, SAT, ACT, TOEFL, and AP scores.
2. **Online College Placement Test**  
You can take the College Placement Test through Examity's online proctoring services.
3. **Directed Self-Placement**  
You will review course descriptions/expectations followed by a brief questionnaire. At the end of questionnaire, you will select preferred course placement.

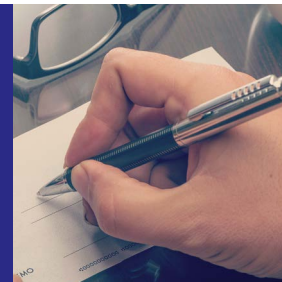

# PAYMENT DEADLINE FOR WINTER/SPRING 2022



## Payment Deadline for Winter 2022:

Payment is due in full by the end of the term: Wednesday, January 19, 2022

## Payment Deadlines for Spring 2022:

If registered from the start of registration through Friday, January 21, 2022, must pay in full, make payment plan arrangement, or have financial aid awards in place by Friday, January 21, 2022.

If registered after Friday, January 21, 2022, must pay in full, make payment plan arrangement, or have financial aid awards in place at the time of registration.

### Missed Payments:

Students who do not make a payment or payment arrangement by the due date risk having all classes dropped and will need to re-register within the published add/drop period.

Students will not be reinstated after the add/drop period has ended.

Students who register on Monday, January 24, 2022 or later will be financially responsible for all charges and will not be dropped for non-payment.

Please adhere to the published add/drop deadlines.

## Educational Opportunity Fund

The EOF Program is a department within the Center for Academic & Student Success

### What is the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program?

For 50 Years, the EOF program has provided students from educationally and economically disadvantaged backgrounds, an opportunity to pursue a college degree. Created by statute in 1968, EOF has provided academic, financial, and social support to thousands of EOF students. EOF has been an integral part of Hudson County Community College (HCCC) since the late 1970's. The Program is geared toward students who:

- Have the potential to do college level work
- Were academically under-prepared in high school
- Have a history of financial disadvantage

EOF is a program that is dedicated to ensuring in school academic success. Our dedicated team of advisors, tutors, and instructors work closely with EOF students to assist them in earning their college degrees.

### What services are offered to HCCC EOF students?

EOF students receive the following support services:

- Academic advisement, counseling, and tutoring
- Early start on college by attending our Pre-College Summer Program (for first-time, full-time college students)
- Workshops, cultural trips, and activities specifically for EOF Students
- Class registration from their personal EOF Advisor
- Mentoring from experienced EOF students
- Career advisement and guidance on transferring to 4 year colleges
- Financial assistance based on the State of New Jersey eligibility.
- The opportunity to transfer into the EOF Program at future 4-year NJ institutions

### Who is eligible for the EOF program at HCCC?

In order to be eligible for consideration, an applicant must:

- Be a full-time (enrolled in at least 12 credits) student from an educationally and/or economically disadvantaged background
- Have been a New Jersey resident for at least one year
- Meet the financial eligibility requirements as defined by the State of New Jersey
- Be a first time, full-time student or be a currently enrolled HCCC student with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 and a maximum of 30 college credits earned
- Minimum ESL Level IV (current HCCC students)

### How do I apply to become an EOF student?

- Complete an HCCC application (new HCCC students)
- File a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form for the academic year for which you are applying. You can apply online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- Obtain the EOF Application from
  - EOF MyHudson Portal Page (current HCCC students)
  - [www.hccc.edu/EOFSummer](http://www.hccc.edu/EOFSummer) (Summer applicants only)
- Submit the completed application with requested financial documentation, academic records, and essay to the EOF office by the posted term deadline

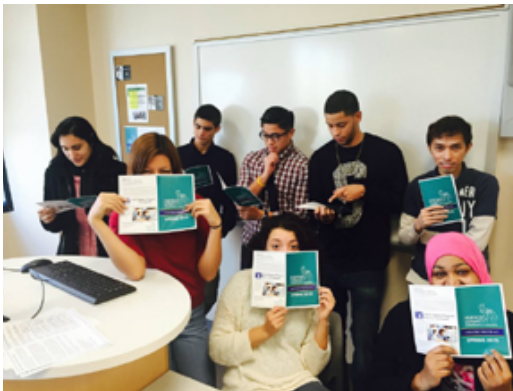

Tuition and fees are subject to change.

**Registration Fee** - This fee is a flat fee charged once per semester and is used to cover costs associated with the processing of registrations.

**Student Activity Fee** - This fee is charged per credit hour to all students enrolled in courses for credit. The funds contribute to the support of Student Clubs and organizations, student activities, publications and Student Government services.

**Technology Fee** - This fee is charged per credit hour to all students enrolled in courses for credit. The funds are used to offset costs, and maintain and upgrade all student lab equipment, library automation and other instructional technology.

**General Service Fee** - This fee is charged per credit hour to all students enrolled in courses for credit. The funds contribute to the support of construction, restoration, and maintenance for various student academic facilities on campus. This revenue also supports services not funded by the State, such as free transportation between campuses.
