The "You Save" represents the money that you will save by first receiving your Associate's degree at HCCC and then transferring to receive your Bachelor's degree.

Prices are based on completing an Associate's Degree in 2 years and a Bachelor's degree in 4 years.

The \$2,706 yearly tuition for HCCC is based on 33 credits (half of an Associate's Degree) at \$82 per credit.

Tuition costs do not necessarily reflect out-of-pocket expense. They are calculated before financial aid and scholarships.
