The College Lecturer will perform his/her duties during a consecutive five-day work week that does not exceed seven hours per day. The College Lecturer will teach Honors classes and provide leadership of the Honors Program in support of the College's mission statement, program policies and procedures, and in accordance with established goals and objectives, policies, and procedures of the Academic Affairs Division.

Requirements: Minimum of a Master's degree in from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. A minimum of two years college-level teaching experience, preferably in honors at the community college level. Demonstrated knowledge of modern pedagogical technology and its use in the classroom. Strong interpersonal and communication skills. Demonstrated ability to provide diverse teaching methods to differing learning styles. Demonstrated excellence in teaching and the ability to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds.

<u>Preferred</u>: Preferred experience in distance education course delivery. Proficiency with various computer software programs, assessment software such as WEAVE, and the use of Ellucian-Colleague or similar higher education platform.
