About the Foundation Art Collection

The Hudson County Community College (HCCC) Foundation Art Collection includes works in media ranging from painting and sculpture to photographs, American craft pottery, and ephemera. The Collection depicts aspects of America's and New Jersey's rich artistic and cultural heritage from the Hudson River School period to the present time. There are more than 800 works by noted American and local artists permanently installed throughout the public areas of the College's buildings in Jersey City and Union City.

The Collection was founded in 2006 to coincide with the initiation of the Hudson County Community College Fine Arts studies program. It is intended to afford HCCC students, faculty and staff – as well as members of the community – with opportunities to view and enjoy the works, and to provide points of reference and inspiration.

Among the artists whose works are installed throughout the Journal Square and North Hudson campuses are Will Barnet, Ricardo Barros, Chakaia Booker, Christo, Chuck Close, Willie Cole, Edward S.
