



# Accessing Canvas using the Canvas App on Chromebook


- Files in .pdf format– Opens on the Canvas application.




- Files in .pptx and .docx format – Will not open in Canvas and it will prompt the user to purchase Adobe Subscription.
- Students should not purchase the Adobe subscription and exit out of this window.




- Files in .pptx and .docx format – Users should download these files to their Chromebook.




- Downloaded files can be accessible by going to the **Files** folder and clicking on **Downloads**.



- Downloaded files will be visible in the **Downloads** folder.




- Downloaded files will open on the **Chrome** web browser.




# Configuring Chromebook settings to enable Canvas access through the web browser


- Look for the Settings menu




- Go to Apps, and look for Manage your apps



- Once inside Manage your apps, look for Canvas




- Select Open in Chrome Browser




## Accessing Canvas using the Chrome browser on Chromebook
