The College owns seven buildings in Journal Square and one building in the North Hudson area. The budget is approximately \$60 MM, and the College employs over 300 full-time employees plus adjunct faculty and part-time employees. Also, the College has a \$50MM capital renovation program in progress.

The College is a comprehensive urban community college with a mission to offer high-quality program and services.

MANDATORY EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY LANGUAGE N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. (P.L.1975, c.127) N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq.

GOODS, GENERAL SERVICES, AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.
