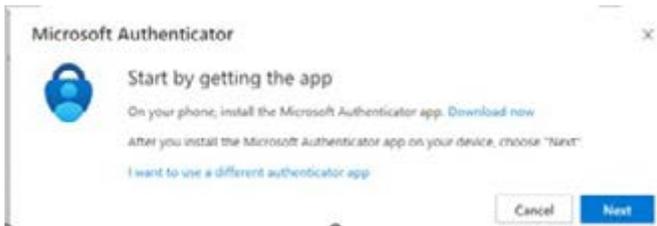

To add the Microsoft Authenticator app for your HCCC account, please follow these steps:



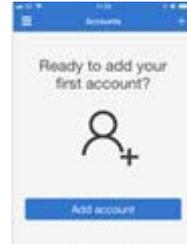
1. You will be brought onto a screen telling you to download the Microsoft Authenticator. Search for the Microsoft Authenticator app on your phone's App Store and download it.



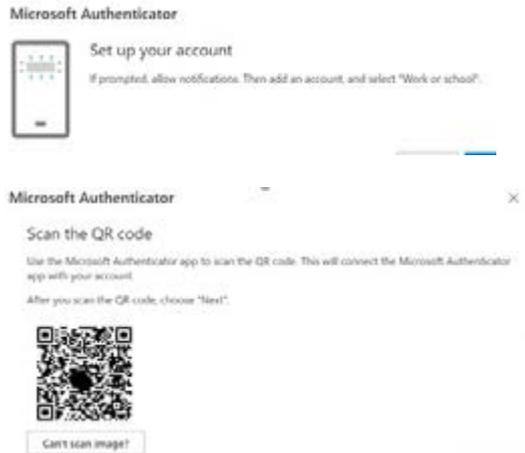
2. On your phone, you will now see the **Microsoft Authenticator** app.



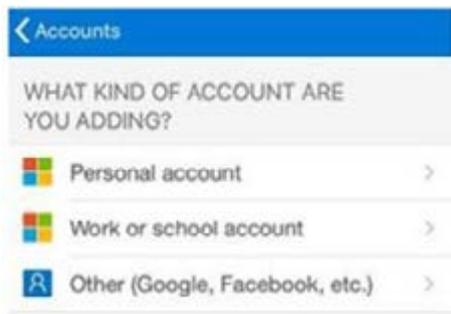
3. Skip any Intro screens the app may present until you reach the Ready to add your first account? Screen.



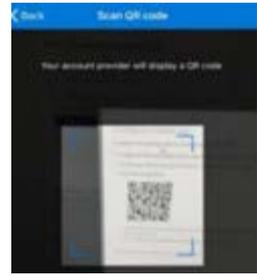
4. On your **computer's browser**, click Next until you get the screen of the QR code.



5. On your **phone**, click on **Add Account**, and then select **Work or School account**.



6. Your phone will prompt to allow the use of the camera. Click Allow, then point your camera at the QR code on your **computer's** screen.



7. Click Next after scanning the QR code.

Use the Microsoft Authenticator app to scan the QR code. This will connect the Microsoft app with your account.

After you scan the QR code, choose "Next".

8. On the **computer's** screen, you will see a number. On the **phone**, type in the number on the screen.
