- 1 What is ITV?**

Interactive Television (ITV) classes are held in state-of-the-art, fully immersive video classrooms at both campuses simultaneously and provide a seamless visual and sound connection. The instructor is equally available to students on both campuses and is assisted by technical and tutoring support.
- 2 Where is ITV on campus?**

ITV Spaces include: L418, N504, A418, N703A, NHC Multipurpose Room, Culinary Scott Ring Room, Culinary Johnston Breakout Rooms, and Culinary Banquet Room, and STEM Multipurpose Room.
- 3 How does ITV work?**

ITV Spaces are powered by WebEx technology. There are high-quality cameras, displays, microphones, and speakers that provide an immersive experience.
- 4 Are classrooms with Smart TVs considered ITV rooms?**

No, ITV rooms include built-in TVs, cameras, and sound systems using WebEx technology.
- 5 What is the advantage of using these rooms?**

All of the technology is built-in and meant to work together. The system provides an immersive experience for those in the room.
- 6 How do you use the document camera in the room?**
