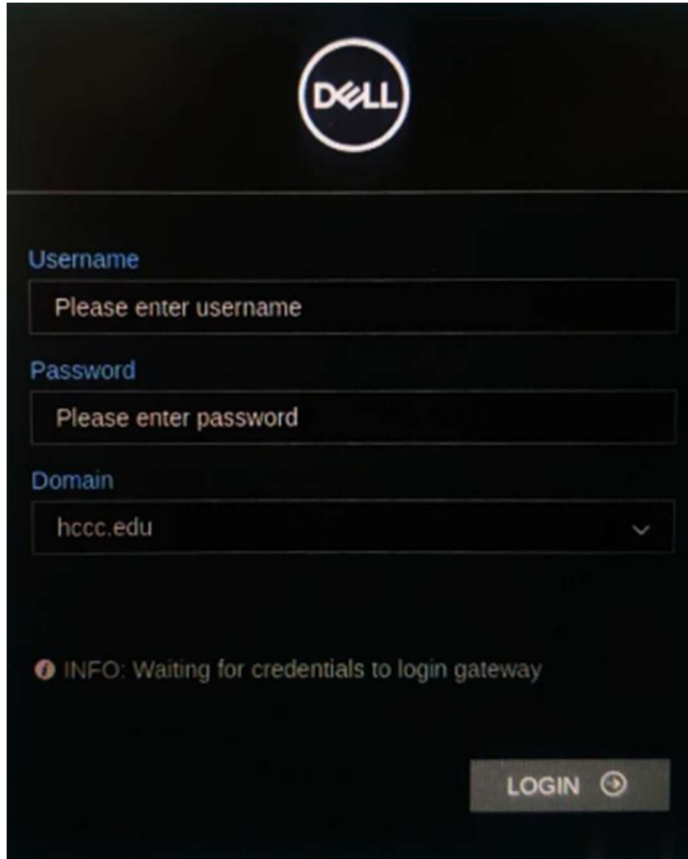


VDI Computers STEM Guide – For Students/Faculty/Staff

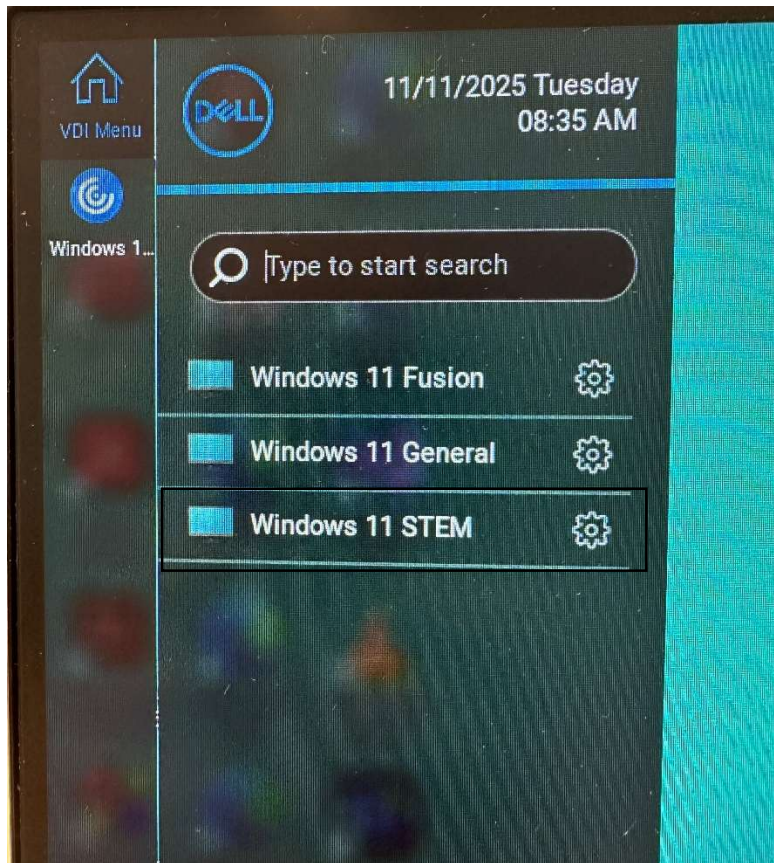

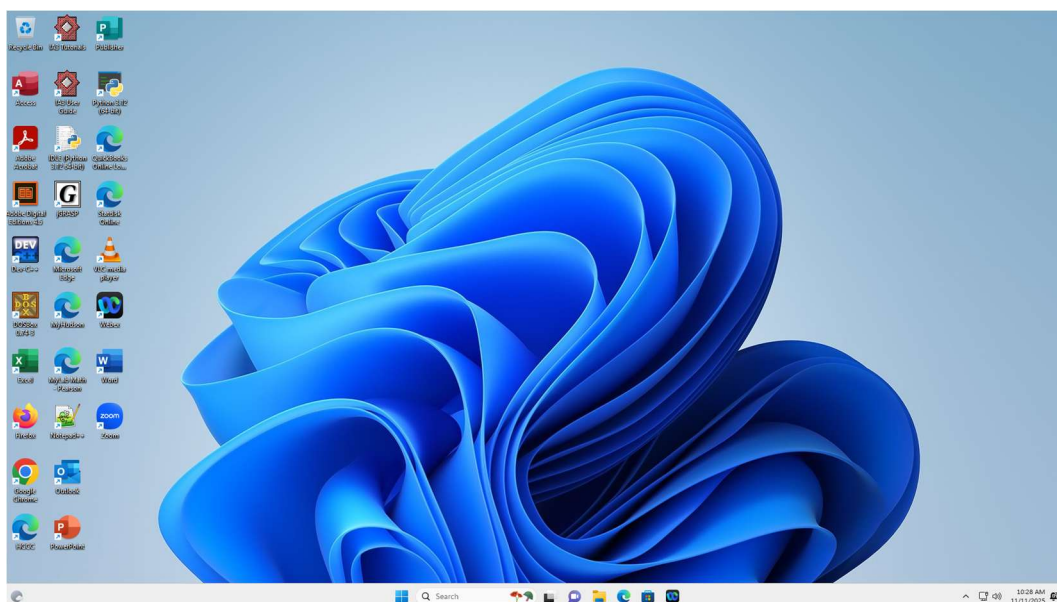
How to Switch from Windows to STEM Image

Please be aware that it is possible to switch from windows to STEM image or vice versa. The purpose of having both images (Windows and STEM) is so that you will be able to use the available programs.

Step 1- Right click in the left side of the computer to display the vertical bar as shown in the picture.



Step 2: Click OK on the inactivity notification. You can now begin to use the computer



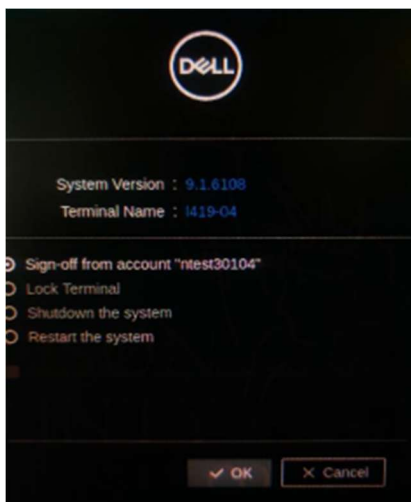
How to Sign Out (Both Images - Windows and STEM)

With this method, you only need to sign out once whether you used one image or both of them (Windows and/or STEM).

Step 1- Right click on the left side of the computer to display the vertical bar shown in the picture.



Step 2: You will get a window with options. Make sure the “Sign off from account” option is selected and click OK.
