BACKGROUND:

Hudson County Community College is located in Jersey City and North Hudson area. The College has a student enrollment of over 8,800 credit students and 7,500 non-credit students. The College owns seven buildings in Journal Square and one building in the North Hudson area. The budget is approximately \$60 MM, and the College employs over 300 full-time employees plus adjunct faculty and part-time employees. Also, the College has a \$50MM capital renovation program in progress.

The College is a comprehensive urban community college with a mission to offer highquality program and services.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

College management writes the management, discussion, and analysis report and prepares the financial statements except for the cash flow statement. The scope of services is to complete 2021 audit of the College books, including financial statements, grants, credit hour programs, and requirements of the College for the fiscal ending June 30, 2021.

Requirement # 1- Financial Statements

 Audit of the Financial Statements - the audit will be in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 34/35 and 14/39 (GASB) and the standard applicable to Financial Audits contained in Government Auditing Standards issued by the Controller General of the United States.

This includes a report on compliance and internal control over financial reporting based on an audit of financial statements performed in accordance with the Government Auditing Standards.

- Completion of all of the audit work for the audited Financial Statements to be presented no later than the January 2022 Board of Trustees meeting.

MANDATORY EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY LANGUAGE N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. (P.L.1975, c.127) N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq.

GOODS, GENERAL SERVICES, AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.
