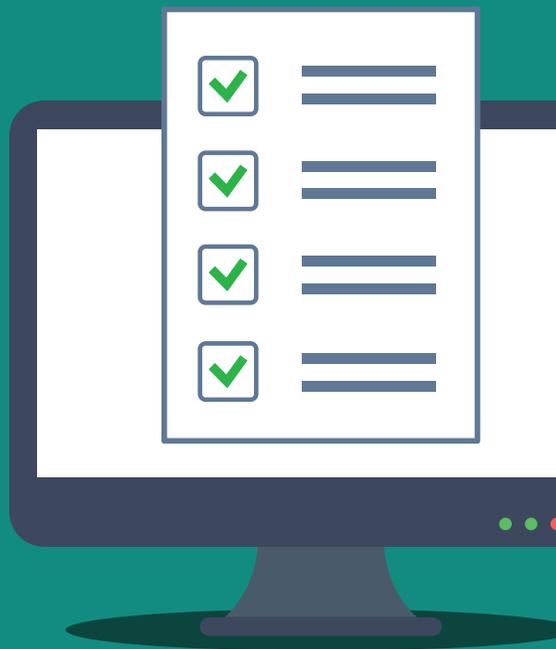


HCCC College Placement: *You Have Options!*

When enrolling at HCCC, students can choose from three options to determine their college placement:

1. **College Placement Exemptions**
You may be eligible for college-level coursework by submitting qualifying High School transcripts, SAT, ACT, TOEFL, and AP scores.
2. **Directed Self-Placement**
Choose your course placement by reviewing course descriptions/expectations followed by a brief questionnaire.
3. **College Placement Test**
Take the College Placement Test in person or remotely through Examity's 24/7 online proctoring services.

PAYMENT DEADLINE FOR SUMMER/FALL 2023



Payment Deadline for Summer I

- Payment is due by the end of the term: Monday, July 3, 2023

Payment Deadline for Summer II

- Payment is due by the end of the term: Tuesday, August 22, 2023

Payment Deadline for Fall

- If registered from the start of registration through Wednesday, August 30, 2023, must pay in full, make payment plan arrangement, or have financial aid awards in place by Wednesday, August 30, 2023.

If registered after Wednesday, August 30, 2023, must pay in full, make payment plan arrangement, or have financial aid awards in place at the time of registration

Missed Payments:

Students who do not make a payment or payment arrangement by the due date risk having all classes dropped and will need to re-register within the published add/drop period.

Students will not be reinstated after the add/drop period has ended.

Students who register on Wednesday, August 30, 2023, or later will be financially responsible for all charges and will not be dropped for non-payment.

Please adhere to the published add/drop deadlines.

Registration Fee - This fee is a flat fee charged once per semester and is used to cover costs associated with the processing of registrations.

Student Life Fee - This fee is charged per credit hour to all students enrolled in courses for credit. Departments and programs receiving funding from this fee may include: Student Life and Leadership, Student Government Association, Student Clubs and Activities, Honor Societies, Cultural Affairs, Career Services, Advising & Transfer, Academic Affairs, and costs related to graduation events and Commencement.

Technology Fee - This fee is charged per credit hour to all students enrolled in courses for credit. The funds are used to offset costs, and maintain and upgrade all student lab equipment, library automation and other instructional technology.

General Service Fee - This fee is charged per credit hour to all students enrolled in courses for credit. The funds contribute to the support of construction, restoration, and maintenance for various student academic facilities on campus. This revenue also supports services not funded by the State, such as free transportation between campuses.

Educational Opportunity Fund

The EOF Program is a department within the Center for Academic & Student Success

What is the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program?

For over 50 years, the EOF Program has provided students from educationally and economically disadvantaged backgrounds, an opportunity to pursue a college degree. Created by statute in 1968, EOF has provided academic, financial, and social support to thousands of EOF students. EOF has been an integral part of Hudson County Community College (HCCC) since the late 1970's. The Program is geared toward students who:

- Have the potential to do college level work
- Were academically under-prepared in high school
- Have a history of financial disadvantage

EOF is a program that is dedicated to ensuring in-school academic success. Our dedicated team of advisors, tutors, and instructors work closely with EOF students to assist them in earning their college degrees.

What services are offered to HCCC EOF students?

EOF students receive the following support services:

- Academic advisement, counseling, and tutoring
- Early start on college by attending our Pre-College Summer Program (for first-time, full-time college students)
- Workshops, cultural trips, and activities specifically for EOF Students
- Class registration from their personal EOF Advisor
- Mentoring from experienced EOF students
- Career advisement and guidance on transferring to 4-year colleges
- Financial assistance up to \$800 based on the State of New Jersey eligibility
- The opportunity to transfer into an EOF program at future 4-year NJ institutions

Who is eligible for EOF at HCCC?

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must:

- Be a full-time (enrolled in at least 12 credits) student from an educationally and/or economically disadvantaged background
- Have been a New Jersey resident for at least one year
- Meet the financial eligibility requirements as defined by the State of New Jersey
- Be a first time, full-time student or be a currently enrolled HCCC student with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 and a maximum of 30 college credits earned

How do I apply to become an EOF student?

- Complete an HCCC application (new HCCC students)
- File a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the academic year you are applying. You can apply online at www.FAFSA.gov

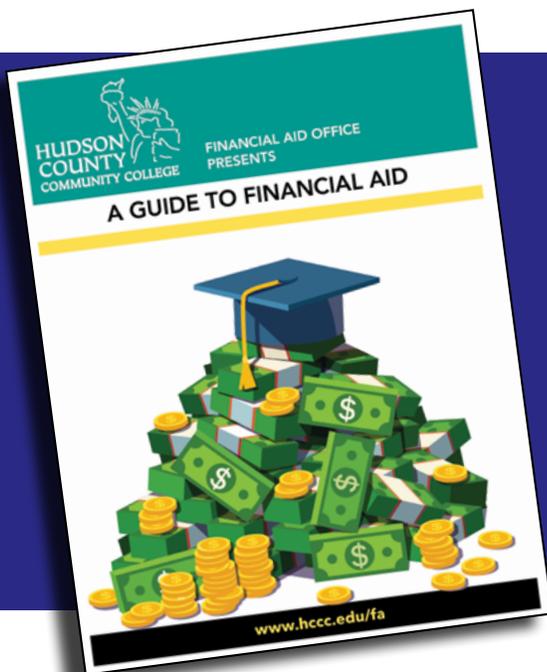

Community College Opportunity Grants (CCOG) are awards that will pay the costs of tuition and approved educational fees not already covered by other available grants applied to the student's account for New Jersey residents with an annual adjusted gross income (AGI) between \$0 and \$65,000. For New Jersey residents with AGIs between \$65,001 and \$80,000 CCOG will pay up to half of the maximum CCOG award available at the college.

Who is eligible for tuition-free Community College:
Community College Opportunity Grants are available to students who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a New Jersey resident with a total household adjusted gross income between \$0 - \$80,000
- Complete the FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application by applicable state deadlines
- Enroll in at least six (6) credits per semester at HCCC during Academic Year 2022-2023
- Have no prior college degree
- Make satisfactory academic progress
