

Seeking a deeper connection to his roots, Chef Brian ventured to Spain and Portugal. There, he worked at Bel Canto in Lisbon, Portugal and the Parador Hotels in Spain, further enhancing his understanding of the authentic cuisine from that area.

Upon his return to the United States, he took on the role of Chef de Cuisine at Lita in Aberdeen, NJ, which earned recognition from *Esquire Magazine* as one of the Best 50 New Restaurants in 2023.

Chef Brian's professional journey has been featured not only in print but also on various television shows. He appeared on Beat Bobby Flay in an episode titled "How You Bean," as well as on Chopped and, more recently, Alex vs. America.

Currently, Chef Brian holds the position of Executive Chef at Mercado Montclair. He is happily married to his wife Denise, and together they are parents to two young children.

It was another momentous year at Hudson County Community College, as a record 1,550+ students graduated at our 2025 Commencement ceremony, and our innovative Hudson Scholars Program continued to garner national acclaim, further bolstering its reputation as a pioneer in creating transformative outcomes for community college students.

There's no question that 2025 was a remarkable year for HCCC—and it was also another strong year for the HCCC Foundation. This year takes on added significance as the College celebrates its 50th Anniversary with a series of inspiring events and initiatives.

The HCCC Foundation is strongly committed to the belief that all Hudson County residents should be afforded the opportunity to acquire a college education and enjoy the lifelong benefits and transformative power of higher education. The Foundation also hosted signature events such as the annual Golf Outing, Donor Scholar Reception, and Subscription Dining Series which continue to raise vital funding for student scholarships. As Hudson County Community College commemorates its 50th Anniversary, the Foundation is proud to contribute to this milestone year through fundraising and programming efforts that align with the yearlong celebration, which is being led by a hardworking committee of dedicated staff, faculty, and external stakeholders.

Under the leadership of Vice President for Advancement and Communications and Executive Director of the Foundation, Nicole Bouknight Johnson and Foundation Board Chair, Ronnie Sevilla, the Foundation is building on its momentum to ensure generations of HCCC students are supported, empowered, and inspired—fifty and forward.
