

Designing Learner-Centered and Equitable Courses

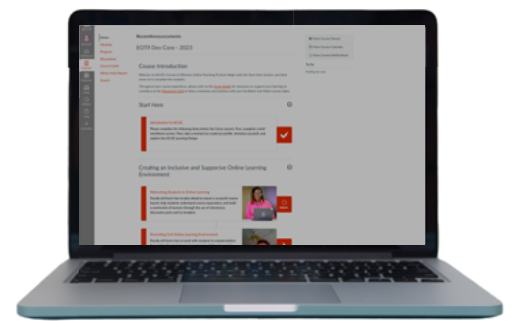

ACUE's course, Designing Learner-Centered and Equitable Courses, supports instructors who are building a course from the ground up as well as those teaching predesigned courses. Completing this course is one step toward becoming certified in ACUE's Effective Teaching Practice Framework, endorsed by the American Council on Education (ACE). This course contains 6 modules that take approximately 8 weeks to complete.
