Helping Make College More Affordable

Our records show that, based on your financial aid application, you may be eligible for the **Community College Opportunity Grant (CCOG)**. This grant can help cover tuition and approved fees at Hudson County Community College.

What Is CCOG?

The Community College Opportunity Grant (CCOG) is a last-dollar scholarship designed to make community college more affordable for New Jersey students.

- **Last-dollar** means CCOG is applied after other grants (such as the Federal Pell Grant) are used.

Important to Know

- Your CCOG amount is an **estimate**
- The final amount may change after:
 - You register for classes
 - Your financial aid is fully finalized
- **Time is ticking** — don't miss your chance to receive this funding!

What You Need to Do Now

- ✓ Register for your classes
- ✓ Check your financial aid status in Self-Service
- ✓ Submit any required documents (if applicable)

How CCOG Pays Tuition & Fees

Example 1 – Tuition Fully Covered	
Description	Amount
Tuition and Fees	\$3,500
Less: CCOG	-\$3,500
Tuition Balance	\$0

Example 2 – With Other Aid	
Description	Amount
Tuition and Fees	\$3,500
Less: Pell Grant	-\$2,000
Less: CCOG	-\$1,500
Tuition Balance	\$0

In both examples, CCOG helps bring your tuition balance to \$0.
