FREE Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) now for **Spring and Summer Enrollment!**

Financial Aid Begins with FAFSA...

Use your 2019 federal tax return. Go to studentaid.gov to begin

File your 2022-2023 FAFSA for Fall 2022 Enrollment now. Use your 2020 federal tax return. State deadline to file is April 15!

Be sure to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the application to import your tax information for both student and parent. This will help ensure no tax information mistakes are made!

Meet state deadline of March 1 by completing your file with any missing documents. Go to nifams.

hesaa.org to view your file

By filing the FAFSA, you may be eligible for both federal and state grants such as Pell, Federal Work-Study, TAG, or CCOG.

Be sure to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress in your coursework by doing the following to ensure financial aid eligibility:

2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA)

Successfully complete 67% of all coursework attempted

Complete your degree within 150% of the credit hours required for your degree.


