File your 2022-2023 FREE Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by February 15 for the Spring 2023 and Summer 2023 enrollment! HCCC school code is 012954.

File your 2023-2024 FAFSA for Fall 2023

semester by April 15 state deadline!

Use your 2021 federal tax return.
Go to studentaid.gov to begin.
Be sure to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the application to import your tax information for both student and parent. This will help ensure no tax information mistakes are made! By filing the FAFSA, you may be eligible for both federal and state grants such as Pell, Federal Work-study, TAG or CCOG.

Tier 1 CCOG – for New Jersey residents with AGI's between \$0 and \$65,000.

New Tier 2 CCOG – for New Jersey residents with AGI's between \$65,001 and \$80,000.

CCOG will pay up to half of the maximum CCOG award available at the College.

Another great reason to complete the FAFSA!

Complete your state verification by the March 1 deadline.
