

## SENIOR CITIZEN TUITION WAIVERS

Hudson County residents, who are 65 years or older, may take courses on a space-available basis and have tuition waived if the requirements below are met:

- Must provide proof of Hudson County residence.
- Must reach their 65th Birthday prior to the first day of class. Proof of age is required.
- Students using the Senior Citizen Tuition Waiver may register for classes the first day of Late Registration for each term. Students may confirm Late Registration dates in the Student Refund and Academic Calendar accessible at <u>www.hccc.edu/enrollmentguide</u>, <u>www.hccc.edu/tuition</u>, <u>myhudson.hccc.edu/bursar</u>, or by contacting the Bursar Department.
- Students who register prior to the designated date cannot apply the Senior Citizen Waiver towards the cost of such courses. The dropping of courses will not be allowed for use of accessing the Waiver.
- Students may not be overloaded into a closed course when using a Senior Citizen Waiver. Registration for course is on a space-available basis.
- Students will not be reimbursed and allowed to apply a Waiver to a registration for which a payment has already been made.
- If a student is eligible for Financial Aid, the Aid will first be applied against Tuition and Waived Fees. Remaining Aid, if any, will be applied against the fees that are the responsibility of the student.
- HCCC will waive Tuition, Student Activity Fee, Technology Fee, and General Service Fee. Students are responsible to pay Registration Fee and all other Fees, which are due on the day of registration. The College portion of the Tuition Waiver will not be applied until after all Student portion of fees are paid, and after the last day to withdraw from the semester.
- Nursing, Paramedic Science (specifically EMT classes) and Radiography clinical courses are not eligible for Tuition Waiver.
