COURSE OBJECTIVES:

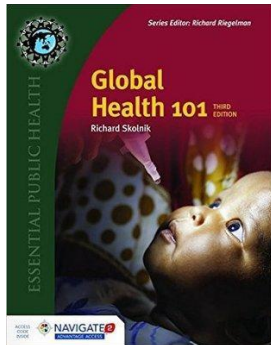
COURSE OBJECTIVES:

6. Evaluate public health responses and health education strategies used in global health prevention and treatment programs.
