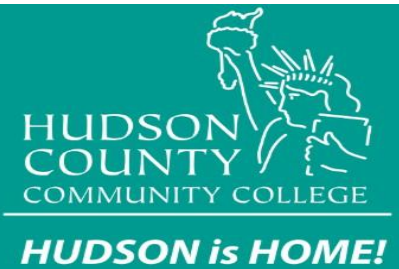

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course focuses on the knowledge and skills learned in the first nursing course. The student will care for patients with simple acute and simple chronic health alterations. Content will be arranged in concepts related to oxygenation, nutrition, elimination, activity and rest, protection, sensing, fluid and electrolytes, neurologic and endocrine function. Pharmacology and QSEN concepts of patient-centered care, teamwork and collaboration, evidence-based practice, quality improvement, safety, and informatics, will be integrated throughout the course. It will include Mental Health Nursing and physical/psychosocial assessment of those experiencing health deviations. Emphasis will be placed on managing nursing care for one patient.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

1. Apply strategies for identifying and managing overlaps in team member roles while providing patient centered care.
2. Utilizes evidenced-based practice and clinical reasoning skills to provide safe and quality care.
3. Demonstrate professional behavior in the clinical setting.
4. Identify quality improvement process that affect outcomes for patients and families.
5. Relate essential information that must be available in a common database to support quality patient care.
6. Utilize critical thinking to prioritize care for patients.
7. Apply ethical and legal principles of patient centered care.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

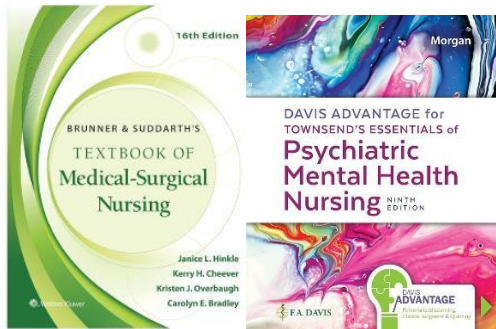
1. Compare the function of the health care team in providing patient centered care.
