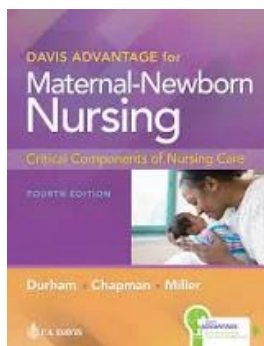
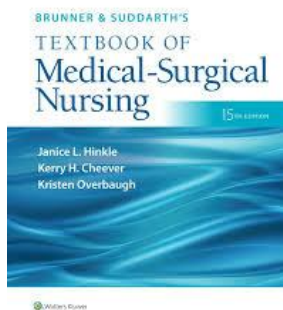
### **COURSE OBJECTIVES:**
