8. Demonstrate responsibility for participation in lifelong learning activities.

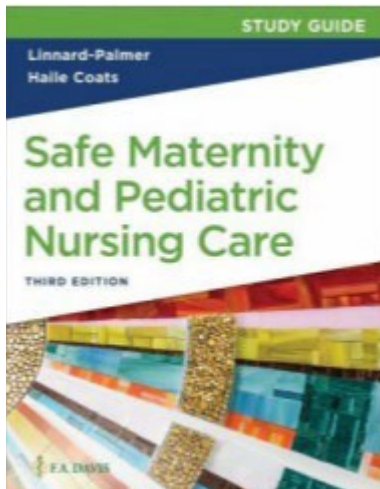
Lab/Clinical
