



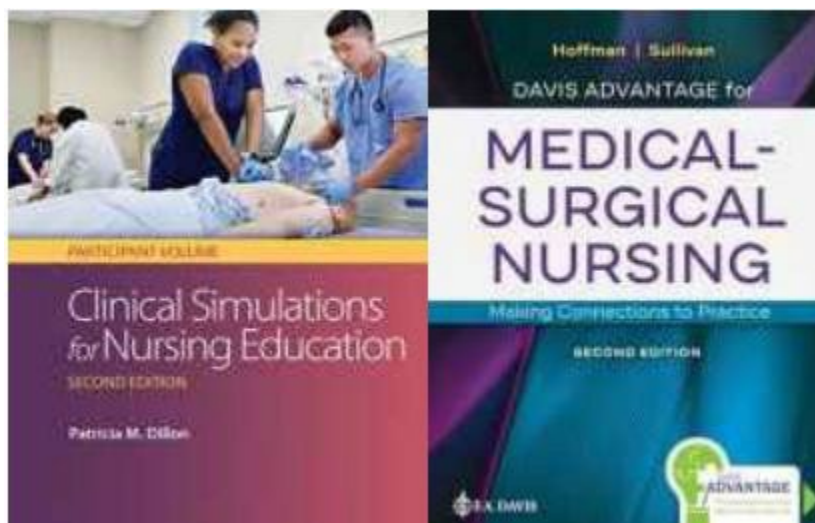
## Lab/Clinical

Clinical attendance is mandatory. Skill lab time is considered clinical time. All absences are to be reported to your clinical instructor one hour prior to the assigned clinical time. All clinical absences must be made up. It is the responsibility of the student to arrange all clinical make-ups with the clinical faculty. More than one clinical absence may result in an unsatisfactory clinical grade and a failure for the course. Written professional 3rd party documentation must be provided.

Students are required to be in the clinical area at the assigned time. Students not present at the assigned time may be dismissed and that day will be counted as a clinical absence except in extreme weather conditions.
