Create and post a Video


To create a video response, there are 3 general steps:

Then click the camera button below the video preview screen. You will see a countdown from 3 and then you can begin recording.



Step 3: Post your video.


Add a cover image or brief description for your video, then choose whether to post it directly to the topic.


Reviewing your Submission:

Responding to your classmate's video:


To respond to a video, you will open it and click on the Comment Icon on the right side of the video.
