



HUDSON COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE (HCCC) CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS WITH TRADE UNIONS

Construction Management program at HCCC has made Articulation Agreements with different trade unions. According to these agreements the apprentices from these trade unions will be able to get course credit in the Proficiency Certificates based on prior education in their apprenticeship programs.

HCCC offers two Proficiency Certificates

- Proficiency Certificate in Construction Administration (16 credits)
- Proficiency Certificate in Construction Technology (16 credits)

Many time students after graduating with Associates or 4-year college degree find hard to get into job market because they lack the field experience. Keeping it in mind small Proficiency Certificates in Construction Management are developed.

Since all our courses are conducted either in-person classes or in remote mode through experienced instructors, students can interact with the instructor for better and in-depth understanding of the course material.

These short Proficiency certificates open the door for students to the job market at entry level positions. At work students get an opportunity for real-time training and by the time they complete their associate or 4-year degree, they are fully trained, confident and ready to perform their duties.

All our instructors come from industry and provide real time field knowledge to the students. The salient features of our program are:

- Short stackable programs for quick entry into construction management.
- Direct exposure to experienced instructors for one-to-one interaction
- Exposure to field experience during education
