## The presenters are *Attitude in Reverse*

The exhibit consists of 277 pairs of shoes to represent the New Jersey youth, ages 10 through 24, who lost hope and ended their lives in the years 2014-2016.\* Most of these people - 196 - were young men. This exhibit lets young people know that they are not alone in their struggles and encourages them to seek help. In addition, the IN THEIR SHOES™ exhibit increases understanding, empathy and kindness towards those who might be struggling in silence.



## GUEST SPEAKER: Assemblywoman Annette Chaparro

Assemblywoman Annette Chaparro has represented the 33rd Legislative District in the New Jersey General Assembly since 2016. She has served on various committees, most recently Community Development and Affairs and Transportation and Independent Authorities committees, and as Vice-Chair for the Law and Public Safety Committee. Her top issues of focus are mental health, pedestrian safety, and senior services. "I grew up in the Hoboken Housing Authority and attended Hoboken High School, which I think as an elected official provides me with a unique connection to my community because I know the struggles of everyday people in New Jersey," said Chaparro. "I believe I am the progressive voice that my district needs, and I say that not only because of who supports me but also because of who opposes me." A lifelong resident of Hoboken, Chaparro currently works as that City's Clerk.
